## **Table II.** CDC criteria for the diagnosis of DSWI (Horan et al., 2008).

- i) Organisms cultured from mediastinal tissue or fluid obtained during a surgical operation or needle aspiration
- ii) Evidence of mediastinitis seen during a surgical operation or histopathological examination
- iii) At least one of the following signs or symptoms with no other recognized cause: fever (> 38°C), chest pain, or sternal instability and at least 1 of the following:
  - a) purulent discharge from mediastinal area
  - b) organisms cultured from blood, or discharge from mediastinal area
  - c) mediastinal widening on X-ray
